ICC Wales opens its doors to agents for the first time

Gun dog handling and falconry was on the agenda for a specially selected group of agents who attended a special familiarisation trip showcasing both the new ICC Wales and the Celtic Manor Resort this month.

This was followed by a hard-hat tour of the ICC Wales site, giving guests an opportunity to experience the venue first-hand before it officially opens. When it opens this year, ICC Wales will accommodate 5,000 delegates and includes a 4,000sqm pillar-free main hall, a 1,500-seated auditorium, 12 flexible meeting rooms, a double-height glass atrium with views of the surrounding Coldra Woods and a 2,500sqm outdoor plaza.
